Good book... Caro is a good comparison. Some of the contrasts he draws are interesting and useful. Others are less clear and equate to, "Sometimes this works, sometimes it doesn't". I sat

down at a cash game after reading about half the book and found I was trying to draw conversation out of opponents and wondering if I was giving anything away. I clammed up and just listened - applied some of the things I learned in the book against the play styles I had learned and felt like that was the right balance to strike (I ended up +\$600 in a \$1-2 NLH five hour session, but it was a soft table).

I've been a successful professional poker player for over ten years, and I still managed to learn more than a few things from Zach's book. I doubt that anyone in the world has studied and catalogued the things poker players say as thoroughly as Zach does here. He explains the logic behind different types of comments and provides real life examples, from both his own experience and televised poker hands, of players revealing information about their hands in the ways that he discusses. Verbal Poker Tells is an invaluable resource both for figuring out your opponents and for convincing yourself to keep quiet lest you reveal valuable information about your own hand!
