I waited so impatiently for this second book in the Ashes & Embers series and I have to say that I'm very disappointed with this story. In Storm, which was so romantic and hot, we're introduced to Vandal. He's dark and broody and you just know his story is going to be hot - NOT!! Vandal has a horrific car wreck in which his five year old daughter dies along with one of his f**k buddies. This, of course, sends him into a deep depression. Also, another person died in the crash, a man who was traveling with his wife. Vandal is, of course, consumed with guilt about this. While visiting the gravesite of his daughter, he notices a young woman who is upset at a nearby gravesite and discovers that she is the widow of the man killed in the crash. They meet, he convinces her to come spend a couple of weeks with him to restore her will to live (really). Well, the most unromantic, BDSM relationship between the two begins. Tabitha, the widow is very depressed over the loss of her husband and really doesn't care what happens to her life at this point. Instantly, it seems, she falls for Vandal, who by the way, isn't very likable. You feel for him about the loss of his young

daughter but the dude is a tough pill to swallow. His cousins and brother in the band, Ashes & Embers, want him to take some time to heal and get his act together, so this is why he decides to spend this time trying to use this BDSM head trip on Tabitha. He thinks its the least he can do for her to bring her back to life. Oh, by the way, Vandal is a cutter, yes he handles his emotional pain by slicing into his legs with a razor blade. I don't really like BDSM books and although I intellectually feel it's fine between two consenting adults, in my heart I think it can be emotionally abusive and demeaning, which I really don't get. But I kept on reading the book bc I wanted to see what happened to this couple when Tabitha found out the truth. While this is not something I could personally participate in and Van was dead wrong for not being able to be honest with her up front, this is still a love story, albeit a really different one. The book has a real surprising twist at the end; I wont give it away but I definitely didn't see that coming. I think this is a book you will either love or hate, I found I couldn't put it down and ultimately, that's a sign of a well written story so I'm giving it 4 stars.
